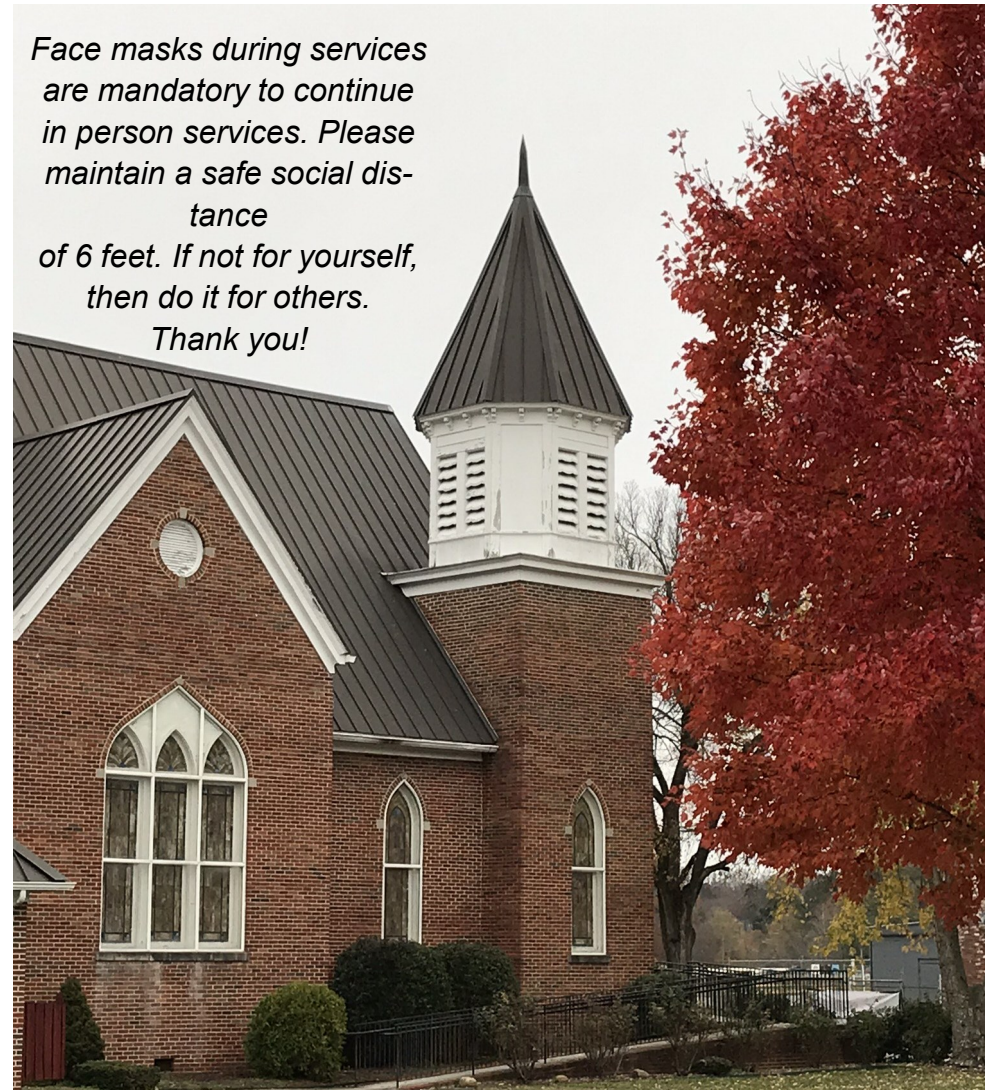

and by which we are saved:

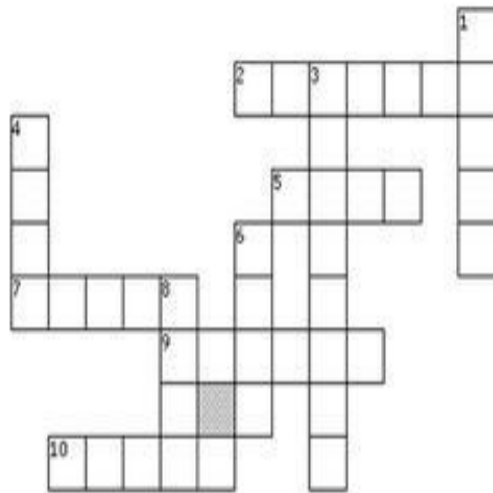
People: Christ died for our sins,
