MINISTRIES**

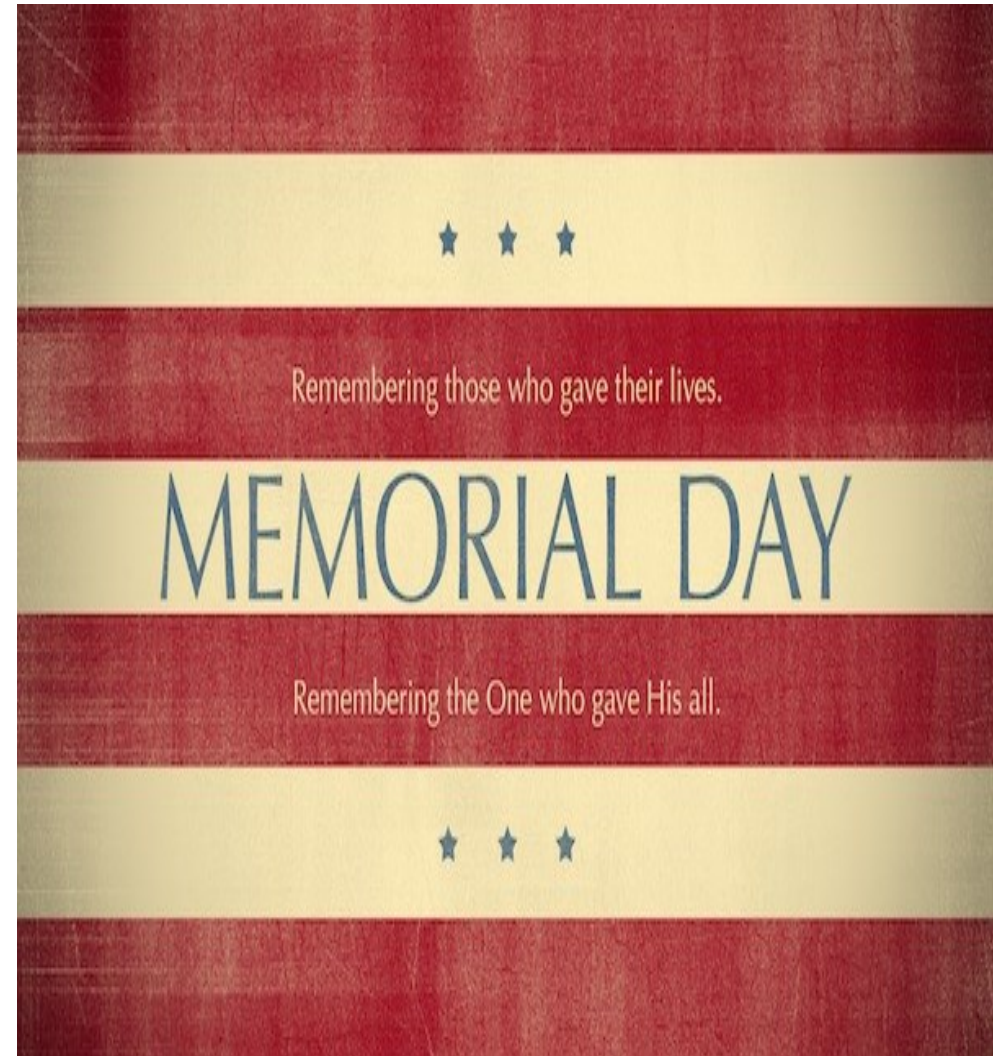

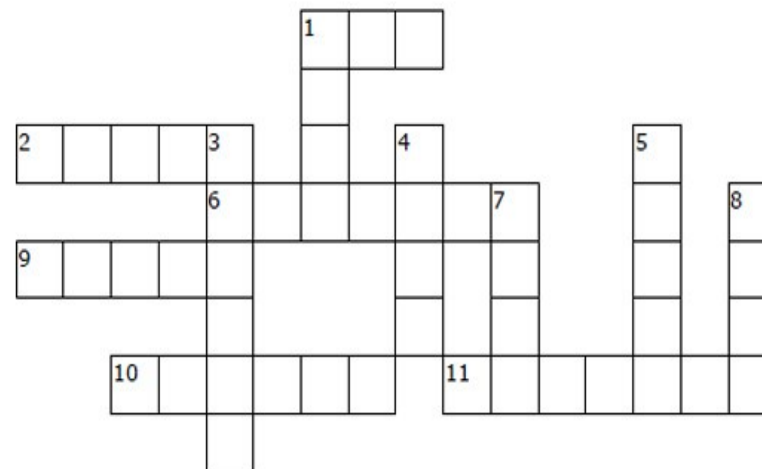
