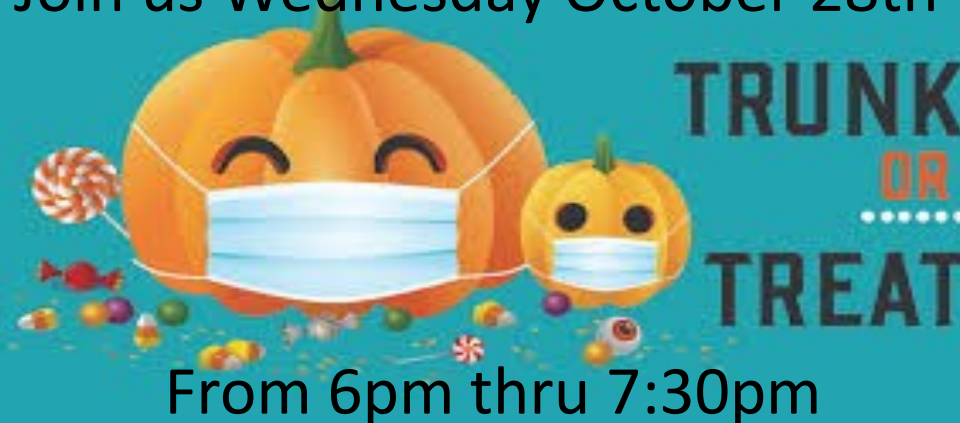
Let's gather at the barn and pavilion and
