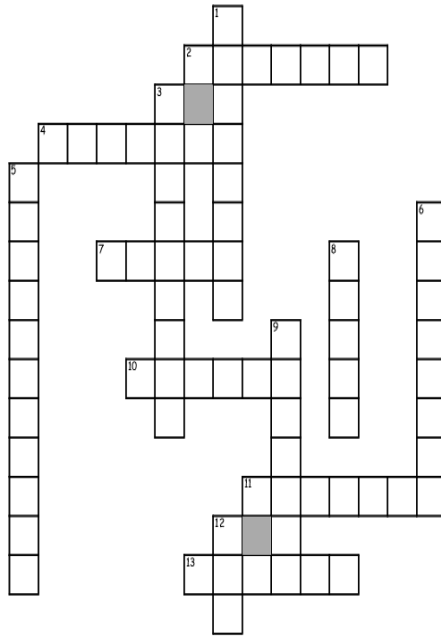

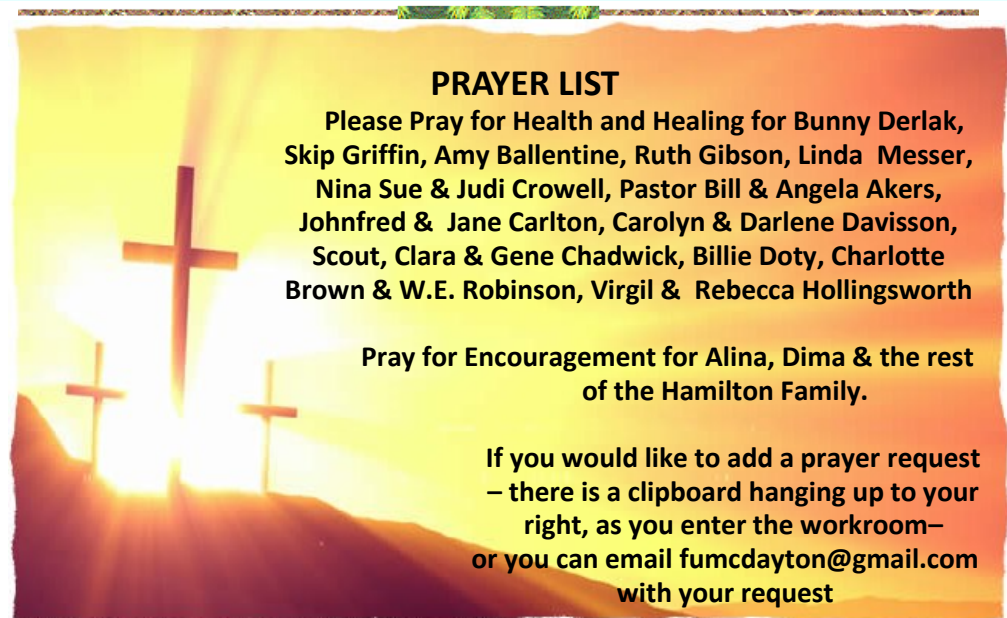

The last two options can be scheduled as a one time gift or repeated at the time interval of your choice.

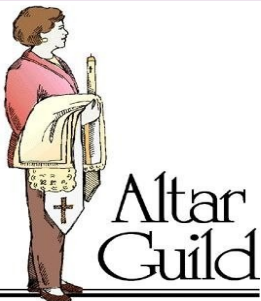

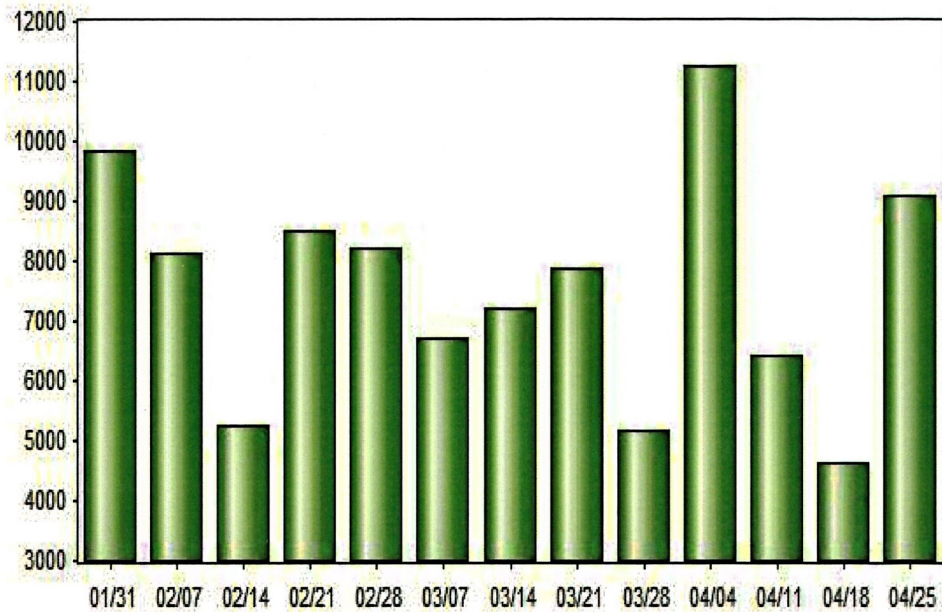

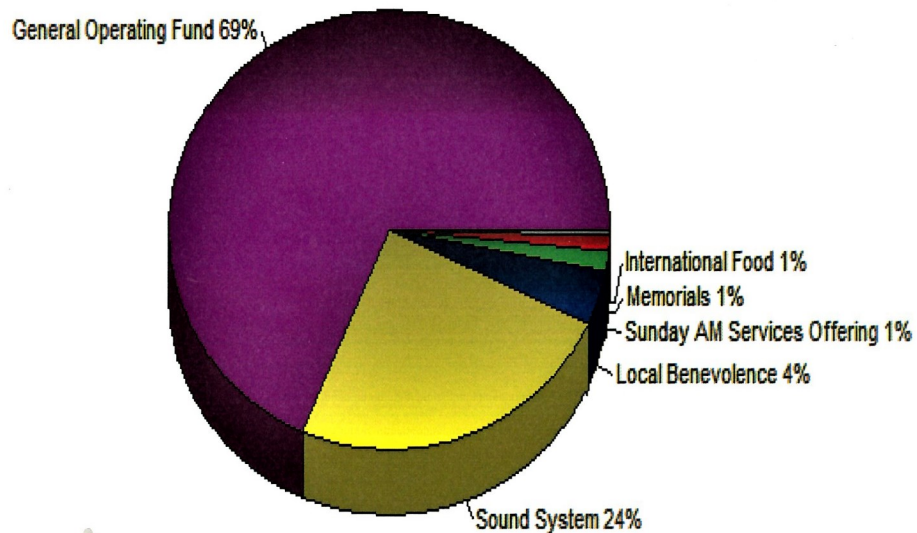
